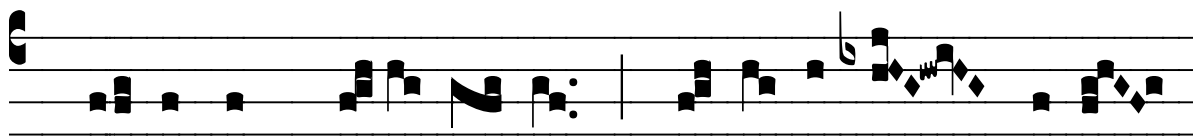

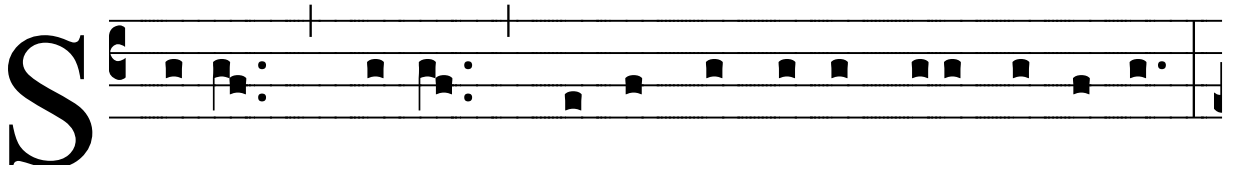
## The Offerory
